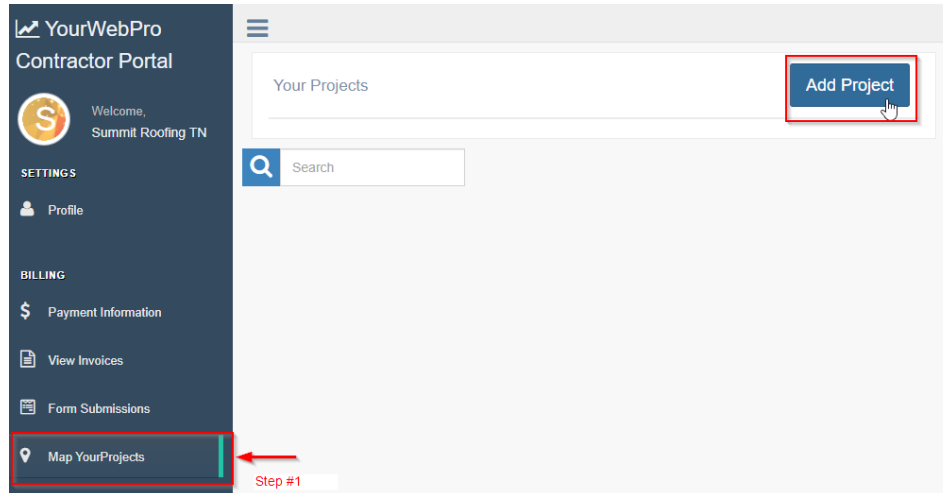
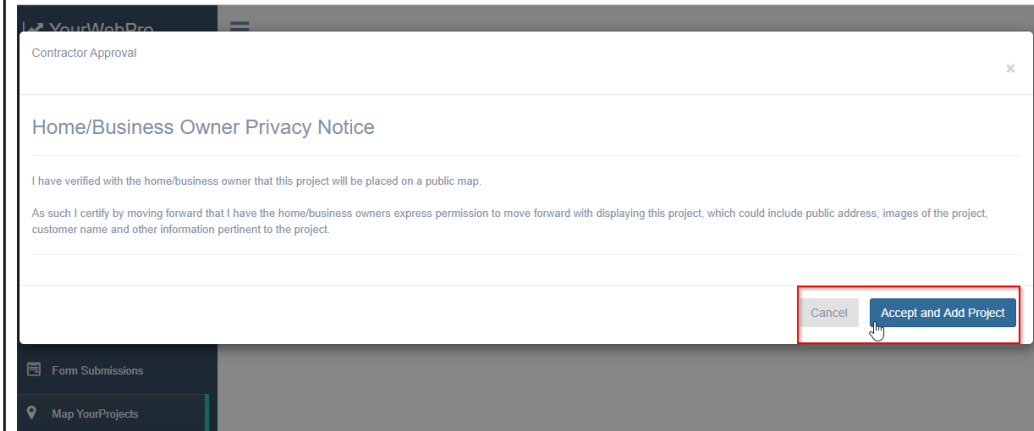


MAP YourProjects - Add a Project

Start: Login to the contractor portal and goto: Map YourProjects on the left menu. Then Click 'Add Project'



Next: Read over the Privacy Notice and select 'Accept and Add Project' or 'Cancel' as applicable. If accepted, proceed to Step 1 - Project Details, Click 'Next'.



Step 1: Complete required fields and select 'Send Review Request to Client' if applicable'. To proceed to Step 2 - Client Address, click 'Next'.

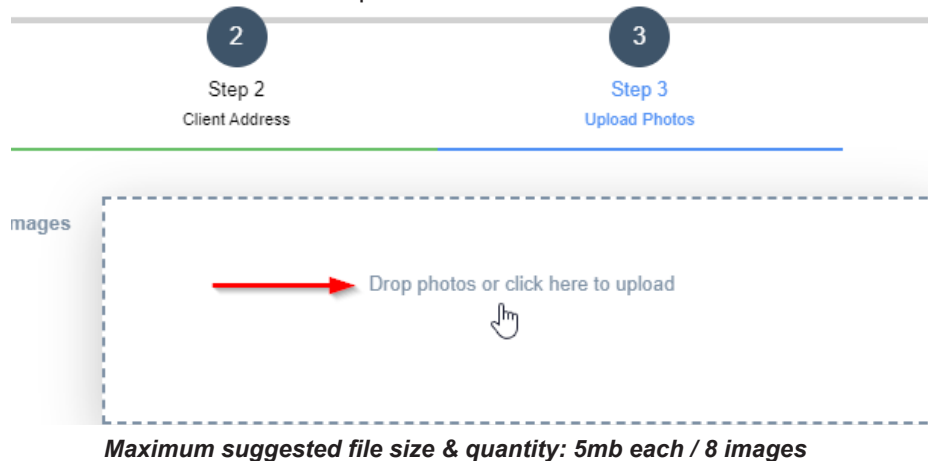

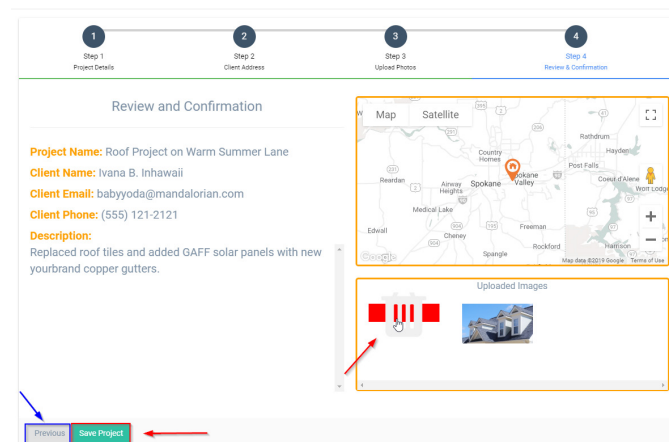

Advanced: Page Title & Meta Description

This feature is available to advanced users who wish to update the Page Title and Meta Description shown in a Google search. Page Title will also update the title tag shown in the browser tab. See examples below and on the continuing section.

In the example shown below, the text highlighted in the red box is the default Page Title displayed from a keyword search. The text highlighted in the blue box is the default Meta Description.

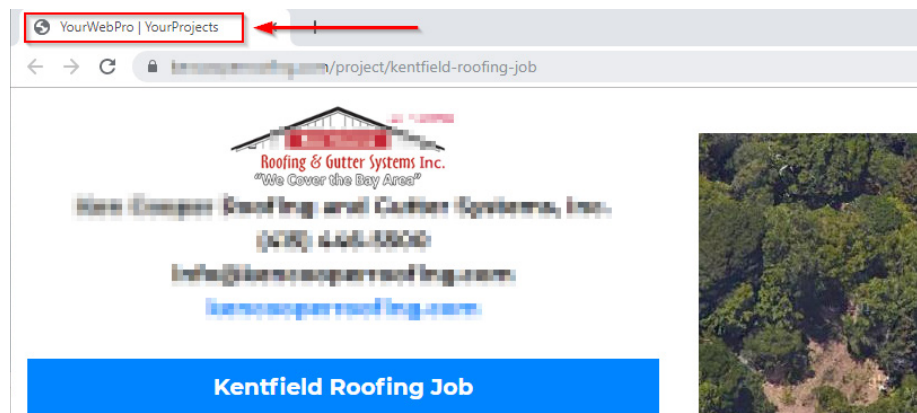
